

Supply List

For fabric templates and step-by-step instructions and videos showing how to make a 'no-sew' blanket, visit www.blankethearts.org.

- 2 yards of 2 different (but coordinating) fleece fabrics (**4 total yards per blanket**)
Ex: (2 yards pattern fleece + 2 yards coordinating solid fleece) x 10 blankets = 20 yards of fleece
- Fabric scissors (i.e. Fiskars or similar)
- 1-2 sheets of cardstock (for 4"x4" and 1"x4" fabric templates)
- 5-10 sheets of cardstock (for printing Blanket Heart tags, 8/sheet)
- Curling ribbon (for attaching a Blanket Hearts tag to each completed blanket)

Tips for Making 'No-Sew' Blankets

- Be sure to cut the coordinating fabrics to the same size for a uniform shape. Fleece dimensions can vary by manufacturer.
- Be sure to cut off the salvage (woven edge on each side from manufacturing).
- Use sharp fabric scissors for best result or have scissor sharpeners available (Fiskars sharpeners can be purchased for less than \$10 at Walmart).
- Use fabric templates for even cuts.
- Braid the long scraps to create a decorative rope to tie and secure the rolled blanket.
